

Our all-day drinking coffee is an indulgent experience with a rich chocolate note combined with flavours akin to a sweet digestive biscuit. The body is well-rounded and the whole brew finishes with very satisfying, long-lasting notes of roasted walnuts.

COAGRICSAL - FT Honduras Arabica Coffee

La Entrada is a town in the Honduran department of Copán. Its name is Spanish for "the entrance" and the town is a gateway from coastal Honduras to the mountainous Western highlands where the coffee farms are situated. Close to La Entrada are the Mayan archaeological ruins at El Puente.

The Cooperativa Agrícola Cafetalera San Antonio Limitada (COAGRICSAL) is an organization of small producers and producers of Coffee, Cacao and Pepper in Central America, it is located in western Honduras, specifically at km 93, international highway to La Entrada Copán

Founded in 1998 with 32 associates, it currently groups more than 1,500 small producers in different areas, which is increasing every year. COAGRICSAL is a cooperative with Social and Environmental responsibility, benefiting more than 1500 families through the generation of jobs and the development of social projects such as:

- Access to Roads
- Community Centers
- Drinking Water Projects
- Maintenance of Schools
- Police posts
